### **Regulations**

#### **1. Announcement**

This Multi-Venue Autotest is to be held under the International Sporting Code of the FIA, the General Competition Rules of Motorsport Ireland ("MI", Appendix 91 of the current MI Yearbook, these Supplementary Regulations and any Final Instructions that may be issued.

#### **2. Organisation**

2.1 These regulations have been submitted to, and approved by, Motorsport Ireland who have issued Permit No. 25/146 for the holding of this competition.

##### **2.2 Event Format:**

The event will consist of driving tests, the details of which will be given at drivers briefing. Diagrams may be placed on the ALMC website ([www.almc.ie](http://www.almc.ie)) during the days prior to the event. As all the tests are in one venue only, there will be no IRDS insurance.

Navigators are NOT required.

Passengers are allowed (CPA €5 Extra) – MINIMUM AGE FOR PASSENGERS IS 18 YEARS

Tests will be designed for Normal Production, Navigation Trial & Retro Type Cars. The venue is not suitable for low Autotest cars.

#### **4 Entries**

##### **4.1) Information:**

Each driver must complete an entry form. Entries can also be submitted on stopastride (stopastride.live) or the attached form can be completed and sent in pdf form to [Deirdre@almc.ie](mailto:Deirdre@almc.ie). Competitors entering on stopastride will be required to sign the attached declaration prior to the start.

The organising club reserves the right to refuse an entry without assigning a reason for such refusal.

**Important Note: Competitors are reminded that they are responsible for making good any damage, caused by them or their cars, to property during a motorsport event which is not covered by the event's insurers.**

##### **4.2 Licence Requirements**

All Drivers must have a valid 2025 competition licence, which must be available for inspection at Check In. One day licences are available on [motorsportireland.com](http://motorsportireland.com), these must be used on the day they are purchased. Please note these are only available to drivers aged **over 18**. If you require any assistance with this please contact William Kelly (087) 2488852 or the Motorsport Ireland office.

#### **4.3 Competitors aged under 18**

Competitors under 18 years of age (Minors) must be entered in the event by a holder of a Minor Entrant Licence who must countersign the entry form. If a third-party Minor Entrant is entering a driver that is not their child, that third party must be Garda vetted and the parent / legal guardian must complete a Minor Entrant Nomination Form which gives the third-party Minor Entrant permission to co-sign the entry form. Minor Entrants Licences are available free of charge from Motorsport Ireland. **It is not permitted to have two minors in the same vehicle.**

#### **5 Classes**

A: All Mini Saloons

D: Non-Mini Saloon Cars up to 1350cc

E: Non-Mini Saloons over 1350cc

F: Road going cars, other than in classes A, D, E

The onus is on the driver to ensure that He/She is entered into the correct class. Ties will be decided by the better time on test 1, and so on. No driver may compete in more than one car. Where 2 Drivers are sharing a car, separate entry forms must be completed, with each form also including the name of the second driver.

Tests will be of an open nature and designed to suit everyone. Use of Seatbelts is compulsory.

#### **6 Competition**

6.1 The time taken for each test will be the penalty for that test, with additional penalties as follows: each initial contact with a pylon: 5 seconds, each line fault: 5 seconds. The maximum loss (including failure) on any test will be the best correct performance in class plus 20 seconds.

**NOTE THAT ALL LINES DURING A TEST MUST BE CROSSED BY A CAR'S LEADING WHEELS ONLY - i.e., STOP ASTRIDE ALL LINES. THERE IS A 5 SECOND PENALTY FOR PUTTING THREE OR FOUR WHEELS (or only ONE) ACROSS A LINE.**

#### **7. Awards**

1st Overall, 1st in Each Class, Best Ladies, ALMC & Beginner Driver. Additional Awards may be presented at the discretion of the Club.

**DECLARATION OF INDEMNITY**
