Format:

The event will consist of driving tests at a single location. Navigators are NOT required-Passengers Allowed CPA €5 Extra (€3 if passenger is aged 16 or 17) – **MINIMUM AGE FOR PASSENGERS IS 16 YEARS**

Tests:

Will be designed for Normal Production, Navigation Trial & Retro type Cars. 2WD Cars Only. Tests are not suitable for low Autotest Cars.

Licence Requirements:

All drivers must hold a valid, in date, competition licence, which must be available for inspection at check in.

One-event licences are now available online.

A user account with a unique email address is required

1. To register an account, visit app.motorsportireland.com
2. When you have logged in, please select [Apply/Renew], then [One Event].
3. Select the date of your event (for multi-day events, the licence is eligible for the entire duration of the event as long as one day corresponds accordingly).
4. After agreeing to a simple declaration, the person will be prompted to pay the €25.00 fee.
5. Once the licence is paid for, it is active and can be used immediately.

Note: Under 18 year olds cannot obtain a One Event Licence

Penalties:

Failure to start at correct time when notified by the Marshals (Unless previously agreed with the COC) will result in a 5 second penalty per Minute late being applied. The time taken for each test will be the penalty for that test, with additional penalties as follows: each initial contact with a pylon: 5 seconds, each line fault: 5 seconds, failure to come to a complete stop (box) 5 seconds, failure to attempt to stop (box) max penalty. The maximum loss (including failure) on any test will be the best correct performance overall from Classes A-E and Class F plus 30 seconds.

Note: ALL LINES DURING A TEST MUST BE CROSSED BY A CAR'S LEADING WHEELS ONLY – i.e., STOP ASTRIDE ALL LINES. THERE IS A 5 SECOND PENALTY FOR PUTTING THREE OR FOUR WHEELS (or only ONE) ACROSS A LINE.

Each Driver must complete an entry form.

Classes:

- A: Saloon Cars UP TO 1000CC FWD
- B: Saloon Cars UT TO 1400CC FWD.
- C: Saloon Cars OVER 1400CC FWD
- D: RWD Saloon and Sports Cars
- E: Retro Cars pre 1987.
- F: Junior Class 14 to 16 years old restricted to 1000cc cars.

The onus is on the driver to ensure that He/She is entered into the correct class. Ties will be decided by the better time on test 1, and so on. No more than 2 drivers will be allowed per car. Where 2 drivers are sharing a car, both names must be shown on the entry form

Junior Competitors:

- Must be accompanied by a Guardian.
- In all dealings with officials of the event must be overseen by Child Protection Officer, in the company of their Guardian.
- All Juniors & Beginners will be given a free practice run through a selected test, must be observed by C.O.C and MI Steward to be assessed on car control and ability.
- All junior competitors will be restricted to competing in a 1000cc saloon car. Forced induction will not be permitted.
- Junior competitors are to be afforded same respect and support as all other competitors and expected to reciprocate same.
- All Under 18 year old drivers Parents/Legal Guardians must have a valid Motorsport Ireland Minor Entrants Licence.

Cars:

- ONLY 2WD CARS ARE ALLOWED. Test will be of an open nature with minimal reversing.
- Use of Seatbelts are compulsory.
- Cars must be in a presentable and roadworthy condition.
- No excessively noisy exhaust systems.

Awards:

- 1st Overall Classes A-E And 1st Overall Class F.
- 1st, 2nd & 3rd in each Class. Best Ladies, GMC & Beginner Driver.
- Additional Awards may be presented at the discretion of the Club.

A copy of the Parents/Legal Guardian's Passport or Drivers Licence must be presented with this form, this copy must include the signature of the Parent/Legal Guardian for use in verifying the signature on the form.

Note 3: The holder of the Minor Entrant Licence must be present for the entire duration of the event.
