1. Venue:

- Údarás na Gaeltachta Industrial Estate, Ballyvourney, Macroom, Co. Cork.
- The event will consist of tests in a single venue. The tests will be designed to suit everyone and will be easy to memorise. No passengers may be carried

3. Entry requirements:

Competitors must hold a valid 2026 Motorsport Ireland competition licence or MSUK equivalent. This must be produced at sign-on. Minor competitors under 18yrs must be accompanied by a parent/guardian that holds a valid Minor Entrant Licence.

4. Results, Timing & Penalties:

As per 2026 Partsworld Munster Autotest Regulations.

Stopastride timing app will be used for timing & results on the day with traditional master sheet used as backup. Competitors will be given times at end of each test and can record if they wish. The Stopastride timing app can also be downloaded to view live timing for the event.

5. Entry Fee:

6. Classes:

- A: All Mini Saloons.
- B: Front wheel drive Mini Specials.
- B1: Non-mini Front wheel drive Specials.
- C: Rear wheel drive Sports Cars and Specials.
- D: Non-Mini Saloon Cars up to 1350cc.
- E: Non-Mini Saloons over 1350cc
- F: Road going cars, other than in classes A, B, C, D, E including multi-venue Autotest cars.
- G: Novices (in the Championship only).
- J: Juniors - competitors under 16yrs, max 1000cc Saloon car.
- K: Beginners - – new competitors with no previous Autotest experience over 16yrs.

7. Awards:

- 1st Overall.
- 1st, 2nd & 3rd in each class.
- Competitors may only receive one award on the day.

9. Timing & Results:

10. IMPORTANT – COMPETITORS UNDER 18

- Competitors under 18 years of age (Minor) must be entered in the event by the holder of a Minor Entrant Licence who must countersign the entry form. A Minor Entrant who is not the parent/legal guardian of the Minor, must be Garda Vetted. Where an adult sits in the same car as a Minor competitor, the adult must be the holder of a Minor Entrant Licence, if they are not the Minor's Parent/Legal Guardian this licence must include Garda Vetting. It is not permitted to have two minors in the same vehicle.
- In all dealings with officials of the event must be overseen by Childrens Officer, in the company of their Guardian.
- All Juniors & Beginners will be given a free practice run through a selected test, must be observed by C.O.C and MI Steward to be assessed on car control and ability.
- All Junior competitors will be restricted to competing in a 1000cc saloon car. Forced induction will not be permitted.
- Minor competitors are to be afforded same respect and support as all other competitors and expected to reciprocate same.
