

MAIDSTONE & MID KENT MOTOR CLUB LIMITED EVENING AUTOTEST SERIES 2026

SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

1. The Maidstone & Mid Kent Motor Club Limited will organise a Clubman status Grass Evening Autotest series on the following Wednesday evenings :-

13 th May	Stoneacre Farm, Otham, Kent ME15 8RS
27 th May	Headcorn Aerodrome, Kent TN27 9HX
3 rd June	Otham
24 th June	Otham
8 th July	Headcorn
5 th August	Otham

2. The meeting will be held under the National Competition Rules of the Motorsport UK, (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA), these Supplementary Regulations (compiled using the 2026 National Competition Rules Edition 3) and any written instructions that the organising club may issue for the event.

3. Each event will be run under an Evening Autotest Permit issued by Motorsport UK, as follows:-

13 th May	Permit No. 207730
27 th May	Permit No. 207731
3 rd June	Permit No. 207732
24 th June	Permit No. 207733
8 th July	Permit No. 207734
5 th August	Permit No. 207735

Permits will be on display at each event.

4. The events are open to entries from :
- a) all current members of Maidstone & Mid Kent Motor Club Ltd;
 - b) current members of the Weald Motor Club;
 - c) current members of up to 14 other Motorsport UK recognised clubs. Any such entry will be deemed acceptance of an invitation on behalf of that club.

5. All Events, except for the 24th June 2026, are rounds of the Southern Autotest Championship (Permit No. CH2026/A011)

6. All competitors and passengers must be in possession of a valid **Club Membership Card and an RS Clubman Competition Licence as a minimum. (NCR 19.7.1.1)** (Note – anyone who is disqualified from holding a RTA Driving Licence cannot hold a Motorsport UK Competition Licence)

7. **Passengers are not allowed** on any timed test for Classes **A-F (NCR 19.4.1.1)**. **Passengers must be carried** on all timed tests for Classes **J and P (NCR 19.5.2.1)**

8. The programme of the meeting for each event will be as follows:-
- Scrutineering will be dealt with in accordance with Motorsport UK Guidance.
 - Each event will start at 6.30 p.m.
 - Any competitor absent by 7.30 p.m. may be disqualified.
 - The closing time of tests will be notified at each event.

9. Each event will consist of eight classes as follows:

Autotest

- A.** Front wheel drive Touring Cars up to and including 3.66m (12ft) overall length.
- B.** Front wheel drive Touring Cars over 3.66m (12ft) and under 4.1m (13' – 5³/₄" overall length
- C.** Front wheel drive Touring Cars 4.1m (13'-5³/₄" and over.
- D.** Rear wheel drive Touring Cars.
- E.** Sports Cars.
- F.** Specials and Four-wheel drive Production Touring cars.

NOTE :

Convertible Touring Cars will be allocated to the relevant Touring Car Class if running with the hood up, but if the hood is down it will be allocated to Class E (Sports Car Class).

10. Entries will be accepted from Drivers who are aged **15 years** and over and who are least 135cm in height (subject to any medical or disability exemption) who do not have a valid, full RTA licence (**NCR 19.4.2.1**) provided the vehicle they are entering in is a touring car of no more than 1400cc, without forced induction, for the Autotest.

Production Car Autotest

J. Junior Drivers. – Aged 13 to 17 who do not hold a full RTA Licence.

- All vehicles competing in this class must be by definition “a Touring Car”.
- The vehicle engine capacity must not exceed 2000cc including forced induction.
- Whilst competing, **one passenger must be carried in each car.** The passenger must hold a full RTA Licence, a Motorsport UK RS Clubman licence, be a full member of either Maidstone & Mid Kent Motor Club or one of the invited clubs and be experienced in Autotesting or Autosolos. (**NCR 19.5.3.1**)
- Whilst competing the passenger must occupy the seat alongside the driver and wear a properly fastened and approved seat belt. No other passenger is allowed.

- P. Any other competitor who wants to run with a passenger (including the passengers of Junior's in Class J).
- All vehicles must be series production cars (**NCR 19.5.1.2**)
 - Whilst competing, **one passenger must be carried in each car**. The passenger must hold a valid Motorsport UK RS Clubman licence, be a member of either Maidstone & Mid Kent Motor Club or one of the invited clubs (**NCR 19.5.2.1**)
 - In any Touring car or cabriolet/sports car with the hood erected, the passenger must be aged 12 years or over and be at least 135cm in height (**NCR 19.5.2.4**), or with the hood down must be aged 16 years or over and at least 135cm in height (**NCR 19.5.2.5**);
 - Where the driver does not hold a full RTA Licence, the vehicle must be by definition "a Touring Car" of no more than 2000cc including forced induction and the passenger must hold a valid, full RTA Licence and be experienced in Autotests or Autosolos (**NCR 19.5.3.1**)
 - Whilst competing the passenger must occupy the seat alongside the driver and wear a properly fastened and approved seat belt. No other passenger is allowed.

All vehicle lengths will be taken as stated in the Parkers Car Price Guide, or if not quoted, the manufacturers specification.

All vehicles must comply with the Motorsport UK Technical Regulations (**NCR 7.2**) and be fitted with road pattern tyres only. Any vehicle fitted with tyres which the organisers deem unsuitable will not be allowed to compete. **THIS MEANS NO KNOBBLIES!**

11. Results and Awards

During the event the results will be available on Stopastride.live. Provisional results will be published as soon as possible following the end of each event. Results will be available post event on Stopastride.live and the Club Website www.mmkmc.co.uk.

Awards will be presented at each event as follows:-

FTD	An award
First in each class	An award
Second in each class	An award (subject to 5 or more starters)
Third in each class	An award (subject to 10 or more starters)
Best Novice	An award

Other awards may be given at the organiser's discretion. No competitor may win more than one award.

12. Competitors will be identified by a number allocated by the organisers but the supply of these is the responsibility of the competitors and must be fixed in a prominent position. Competition numbers will be available to download from the Clubs website prior to each event.

13. The entry list opens on publication of these regulations and closes finally, for each event, at 4.30 p.m. on the Tuesday before the event. No entries will be accepted after this time. All entries for competitors, and registrations for marshals and officials must be submitted online via the Club Website www.mmkmc.co.uk and should, where appropriate, be accompanied by the appropriate fee. Payment can be made by Stripe, Credit Card or BACS. No entries will be accepted on the day.

The entry fees are as follows:

Classes A-F & P is £20.00

Class J Free entry for all Juniors (these entries are funded from the prize money received by the club as Motorsport UK 'Club of the Year 2023'.)

A separate pre-event declaration form must be completed prior to the event by passengers in Class J.

14. The maximum entry for each event is 40, and the minimum is 10. The maximum for each class is unlimited, and the minimum is 1. Should any of the above minimum figures not be reached, the field be too wet or the field not be available, the organisers have the right to cancel the meeting or amalgamate classes as necessary. Entries will be selected in order of receipt. Entry fees may be refunded if notification of withdrawal is given to the Secretary of the Meeting not less than 24 hours before the event.

16. There will be six tests. Each driver will have two runs at each test, with the drivers best score at each test to count towards the results. Timing for all classes will be by the Stopastride Live Timing system, timed to 0.1 seconds. The starting signal will be oral. Order of attempting tests will be optional. Practising will not be allowed **(NCR 19.1.2.4)**.
Details of tests will be available to download from the Club Website prior to the event. Please download a copy of the tests and bring them to the event as no test diagrams will be issued at the event.
17. Any protests must be lodged in accordance with Motorsport UK Protests **(NCR 2.9.1)**
18. All other National Competition Rules of the Motorsport UK apply as written except the following which are modified:-
- A Novice is defined as a driver who prior to 01-01-2026 has not won an award, other than Best Novice at an Autotest.
 - For each event, a vehicle may not be entered to compete for the same award more than twice, to be driven by different drivers, but no driver may enter more than once. The number of drivers for any one vehicle is limited to three. **(NCR 19.1.1.4k)**
 - As the whole event takes place on private property vehicles need not be licenced. **(NCR 19.3.1.2)**
 - Hybrid, Electric, Battery powered, and Light goods vehicles may compete in the appropriate classes. **(NCR 19.3.1.4)**

- Marking and Penalties will be as printed in Penalty Table (**NCR 19.9**)
(b & c) *“Not performing a test correctly, etc”* +20 seconds*
(d) *“Striking any marker, etc per mistake”* + 5 seconds
(e) *“Failing to cross or stop at any line, etc”* + 5 seconds

*Plus the lowest by any **Competitor** in the class making an attempt correctly on that run. The maximum penalty (including time) for any test cannot exceed penalty (b) or (c) above. All unless otherwise specified in the **Official Documents**.

A Wrong Test will be as defined in (**NCR 19.1.3.11**).
