**Maidstone and Mid Kent Motor Club Ltd** has been asked to run an **Autotest** by the **Brooklands Museum**, as part of their **Brooklands Relived Festival of Motorsport Weekend**. The venue will be **Brooklands Museum, Weybridge, Surrey**.

The tests will be suitable for all eligible cars, and hopefully typical of period driving tests. Tests will be all forwards – no reversing. All Tests will be set out on the Finishing Straight.

## **Brooklands Relived AUTOTEST**

1. The **Maidstone and Mid Kent Motor Club Limited** will organise a **Clubmans** permit Autotest for **PRE 1960 cars**, on **Sunday 14<sup>th</sup> June 2026** at **Brooklands Museum, Brooklands Drive, Weybridge, Surrey, KT13 0QN**.
2. The **Event** will be held under the **National Competition Rules (NCR's)** of the **Motorsport UK** (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA), these **Supplementary Regulations** (compiled using 2026 National Competition Rules Edition 2) and any written instructions that the organising Club may issue for the **Event**.
3. The Event will be run under a **Clubmans Autotest Permit** issued by **Motorsport UK**, which will be on display on the day. **Permit No.:- 206724**
4. The **Event** does not form part of any Championship.
5. The Event is open to entries from :-
  - a) All fully elected members of the **Maidstone & Mid Kent Motor Club Ltd**;
  - b) Fully elected members of up to the first **15** other **Motorsport UK** recognised clubs received. Any such entry will be deemed acceptance of an invitation on behalf of that Club.
6. The **Event** is inscribed as **National Competitions Authorised for Foreign Participation (NCAFP)**
7. All **Competitors** must hold a valid **Competition Licence** of a grade suitable for the Event
  - Minimum requirement **MSUK RS Clubman Licence**
  - National Competition Licences issued by Countries outside the UK will be deemed valid for British Events (**NCR 6.3.1.6**)
  - **Licences** and valid **Club Membership Cards** must be produced for inspection at Signing-On.
  - anyone who is disqualified from holding a **RTA Driving Licence** cannot hold a **Motorsport UK Competition Licence**.
8. **Passengers are not allowed** on any Timed Test (**NCR 19.4.1**)
9. The programme of the meeting will be :
  - Scrutineering starts : **08.00 am**
  - Drivers Briefing : **09.45 am**
  - First car starts : **10.00 am.**
  - All times subject to change and will be confirmed in **Final Instructions**.
10. **Final Instructions** - will be sent via email during the week commencing 1<sup>st</sup> June 2026.
11. All drivers must hold a valid full **RTA Licence** or equivalent issued by a foreign country.

12. **The Event is open to strictly Pre-1960 Vehicles.**

13. The **Autotest** will consist of 6 classes as follows :

- A. Pre 1931 up to 1500cc
- B. Pre 1931 over 1500 cc
- C. 1931 – 1946 up to 1500cc
- D. 1931 – 1946 over 1500cc
- E. 1947 – 1959 up to 1500cc
- F. 1947 – 1959 over 1500cc

The organisers reserve the right to further divide classes, amalgamate classes or amend classes once entries close, in the interest of fair competition. The organisers decision will be final. Any changes to the class structure will be notified to all competitors in the Final Instructions and at the Drivers Briefing.

Note :

Cabriolet Saloon Cars must run as Touring Cars with the hood up, or as Sports Cars with the hood down (where applicable).

Vehicle length is to be determined from Parkers Car Price Guide for the car concerned, or if not quoted, the manufacturers specification.

All vehicles must comply with **Motorsport UK** Technical Regulations.

14. Entries open on publication of these Regulations and close finally on **SUNDAY 31<sup>st</sup> May at NOON.**

Entries will only be accepted online using **Stopastride Live Timing** system via the Club Website at [www.mmkmc.co.uk](http://www.mmkmc.co.uk) ,

15. Entry fees will only be refunded if notice of withdrawal is given in writing. Where notice of withdrawal is received before the **Closing Date** entry fees will be refunded in full, after that date refunds, up to a maximum of £35, will be made at the discretion of the organisers (**NCR 6.1.11.1**).

**LATE ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED**

16. The **Entries Secretary** is **Ann Cook** (tel : **07740 248868**) who will deal with all enquiries regarding entries.

17. The maximum entry for the meeting is **40**. The minimum is **20**. The maximum for each class is unlimited. The minimum for each class is **1**. Should any of the above minimum figures not be reached, the organisers have the right to cancel the meeting or amalgamate classes as necessary. Entries will be selected as received.

19. Provisional results will be published, and awards presented, as soon as possible following the end of the event.
20. Any protest must be lodged in accordance with the **Motorsport UK Protests (NCR 2.9.1)**.
21. Awards will be presented as follows :

- No Competitor may win more than one award except for Best Brooklands Club Member
22. Details of tests will be issued at Signing-on.  
Each driver will have a number of runs at each test, with their worst time at each test discounted for awards.  
Timing will be via **Stopastride Live Timing** and mobile phones operated by the start marshals.  
The starting signal will be oral.  
Order of attempting the tests will be strictly as directed at the drivers briefing.
23. Practising will **NOT** be allowed (**NCR 19.1.2.4**), any competitor, in the opinion of the organisers, speeding, or performing handbrake turns or the like, in the paddock or surrounding area may be **disqualified**.
24. Competitors will be identified by numbers, which will be issued at Signing-On, and must be affixed in a prominent position on the vehicle.
25. Marking and penalties will be as printed in **Penalty Table (NCR 19.9)**..:

| (b & c) <i>Not performing a test correctly etc</i>              | + 20 seconds |
| (d) <i>Striking any marker, etc per mistake</i>                 | + 5 seconds  |
| (e) <i>Failing to cross or stop at any line etc per mistake</i> | + 5 seconds  |
- except for (b) & (c) where the 20 second penalty will be 'plus the lowest by that competitor making an attempt correctly at that test layout'.**  
A Wrong Test will be as defined in (**NCR 19.1.3.1**).

26. All marshals will be appointed as judges to adjudicate on penalties **(NCR 19.1.4.1)**.
27. A Novice will be defined as a driver who has not previously won a class or overall award in an Autotest or similar competition of **Clubman**, equivalent or higher status.
28. Pylons may be less than 1 metre in height **(NCR 19.1.2.7)**.
29. As the whole event takes place on private property vehicles need not be licenced **(NCR 19.3.1.2)**
30. A vehicle may be entered twice, to be driven by different drivers, but no driver may drive more than one vehicle **(NCR 19.1.1.4k)**.
31. All other **National Competition Rules** of the **Motorsport UK** apply as written.
32. Please make sure your Vehicle is in good mechanical condition.
33. **Additional Information**

**Competitor Access on Friday 12<sup>th</sup> June 2026.** Competitors will be able to access Brooklands Museum during Friday 12<sup>th</sup> June to drop-off competing cars and trailers, which can be left at the Museum overnight but may need to be moved Saturday morning to the **Competitors Paddock** and the trailer/service vehicle parking area. **If you wish to arrive on Friday you must contact the Event Director – Dave Cook, email [dave.cook@blueyonder.co.uk](mailto:dave.cook@blueyonder.co.uk), for further details.**

Hot and cold refreshments will be available throughout the day in the **Sunbeam Café** or from various food outlets around the Museum site.

Toilet facilities are available in the Brooklands Clubhouse and other buildings around the Museum site.

**Entry Passes.** All entries will receive 2 complimentary weekend passes to **Brooklands Museum**. (Entering another event as part of the Brooklands Relived Weekend will not qualify for any additional passes)

Only the competing car will be allowed to park in the paddock area. Support vehicles and trailers must be moved to the dedicated parking area (normally the visitors car park) located between the paddock area and M-B World Circuit.

All Competitors, their associates, Officials and Marshals must be aware of their behaviour and conduct at all times. Any abusive language or harmful behaviour will not be tolerated. Any incidents should be reported to an Event Official or the Safeguarding Officer.
