1. Announcement

The South of Scotland Car Club Ltd will promote & organise The SOSCC Diamond Jubilee Targa Rally on Sunday 22nd March 2026 under a Clubman Targa Road Rally Permit. The event will Start & Finish at Kames Motorsport Complex

This is a single venue event.

Kames Motorsport Complex, Furnace Road, Muirkirk, KA18 3Q

2. Jurisdiction

The event will be held under the general rules of the Motorsport UK (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA), and these Supplementary Regulations, together with any other written instructions that the organising club may issue for the event.

4. Crew eligibility

4.1 The event is open to members of the South of Scotland Car Club and

East Ayrshire Car Club / Berwick & DMC / Whickham & DMC / Saltire MC Hexham & DMC / Spadeadam Motor Club / Tynemouth MC / Delacy MC / Airedale & Pennine CC / Wigton MC / Solway CC / Kirkby Lonsdale MC / Durham AC / Mull CC / Yorkshire Wolds MC

The entry fee is £110 and includes, 2 lunch Vouchers and a great days Motorsport of 17 tests

4.2

All competitors MUST produce a valid MSUK Club membership card, and MSUK R Licence which will inspected at signing on. SOSCC Memberships can be applied for if required

4.3

Drivers must hold a full valid Road Traffic Act driving licence for a car. Navigators must have attained the age of 12

5.

Program subject to Alterations / amendments presented in Finals and Bulletins

5.1 Location

Single venue event (No road sections)

All tests will be on private property, Tar surface

Please note - Fuel is NOT available on site

6. Access

Access to the Start Venue is available from 07:30am onwards.

7. Noise Check

Noise check will open at 08:00am All cars will only be allowed to start subject to compliance with road rally noise regulations: 98Db (A) at 0.5m or 86Db (A) at 2m (at 2/3 maximum revs as per J Appendix 1.)

8 Scrutineering

Follow the arrows on arrival at the start venue to the car parking area. Please Park as directed and report to signing-on. Noise check, Scrutineering and signing on will in the Paddock area

All entrants are directed to MSUK Blue book page 482 Specific regulations for Targa rallies for Guidance and compliance

For Avoidance of Doubt Vehicles must have a valid MOT certificate for use on the public highway

Being a Single venue event Road Tax is not required as per Appendix 11 Part c 2.4

All tyres must be road legal and E Marked Road pattern tyres (competition only tyres and forest tyres are not permitted

A First Aid Kit / Hi-Viz Jacket / waistcoat / OK , SOS Board / Warning Triangle **MUST** be carried.

A small environmental spill kit must be carried in the vehicle complying with J5.20.13

9 Documentation

Final instructions, venue map and any other documentation relevant to the final instructions will be sent by e-mail on Thursday 19th March

On the day of the event, following Scrutineering and signing on, competitors will be supplied with all necessary instructions, test diagrams, timecards to allow them to complete the rally within the overall event timetable. Numbers that will be supplied by the organisers will identify cars.

These must be affixed as detailed in the final instructions

10.

Briefing

There will be a compulsory crew briefing at 09:10am adjacent to the signing on area.

11. Route Information

The first car will leave the start at 09:30 am and thereafter on Start Marshals Instruction.

The event will follow the determined tests sequence

No maps will be required.

The event is single venue with no Public road sections

The competitive part of the event will consist of up to 17 timed tests

12. Notices

Before, during and after the event, official notices will be displayed on the official notice board in the HQ / Start / Finish Signing On at **Kames Motorsport Complex** . It is the competitors' responsibility to check the Official Notice Board.

13. Toilets

Toilet facilities will be available at Paddock Area

14. Refreshments

Local catering will be available for the event.

Hot drinks and breakfast roll will be available from 08:00am onwards within Canteen at the Start / HQ.

Competitors will be provided a Lunch Voucher

Marshals will be provided with Breakfast and Lunch in recognition of their Contribution as indeed without them these events would not run

15. Prohibited Equipment

Competitors may not wear crash helmets or headsets of any type. The use of intercoms for competitors other than those with medical dispensation is not allowed. No pace notes made separately from the test diagrams provided are permitted. The penalty for breaching these restrictions is exclusion from this event

17.Classes & Eligibility

The event is open to any vehicle that complies with Section R.18 of the MSUK Technical Regulations.

All entrants are directed to MSUK Blue book page 482 Specific regulations for Targa rallies for Guidance and compliance

Engines and Transmissions

21.16. Vehicle engines must have: (a) A maximum of four cylinders. (b) A maximum of two carburettor chokes (two single or one double). (c) A maximum of one camshaft per bank of cylinders. 21.17. Engines with more than one camshaft per bank of cylinders may be used providing that they were originally fitted with fuel injection and that the fuel injection system complete with plenum chamber and throttle body is retained unmodified

Classes

Competitors may enter as Novices, Experts or Masters.

There will be the following classes:

MA Masters *with engine capacity 1400cc or less plus up to 1500cc Diesel*

MB Masters *with engine capacity over 1400cc*

EA Experts *with engine capacity 1400cc or less plus up to 1500cc Diesel*

EB Experts *with engine capacity over 1400cc*

NA Novices *with engine capacity 1400cc or less plus up to 1500cc Diesel*

NB Novices *with engine capacity over 1400cc*

Masters: *Driver has won their class on any Rally or Gymkhanas with Special Tests in the last 5 years.*

Experts: *Driver has previously competed on 5 or more Rallies or Gymkhanas with Special Tests.*

Novices: *Driver has previously competed on less than 5 Rallies or Gymkhanas with Special Tests.*

Endurance and Historic Road Rallies count towards this. Class wins, as a Novice on this event and future Targa Rallies do not count towards becoming a Master. Competitors can only enter one class. The Organisers reserve the right to alter classes if they think that is appropriate e.g., less than 2 entries are received for a class.

18.Entries

Entries should be made by the attached Stop Astride Link as below and will only be accepted when full payment has been received.

Telephone entries will not be accepted.

The maximum number of entries is 30 – minimum is 10

The entry list closes at 21:00 Thursday 19th March 2026 .

Refunds for entry withdrawals will be at the organiser's discretion.

The entry fee is £110 per car and crew of two member.

If required, the SOSCC Membership form is provided with these regs.

21. Results

Provisional results will be available on Stop Astride Live finalised prior to the awards presentations. Protests will be dealt with in accordance with C.5. Final results will be published on the South of Scotland Car Club website

22. Penalties

Competitors will start at one-minute intervals, unless otherwise instructed by an official. Penalties will be as R13 – Appendix 1 Char 13 except as modified below:

j) Jump Start	10 Seconds
k) Not completing a test by the correct route other than in (h or i)	Fastest in Class Plus 20
l) Starting but not completing a test	Test Maximum
m) Not attempting a test	Test Maximum
n) The wrong test penalty will be applied as follows, if you make a mistake on a test and pass the wrong side of a cone, or the wrong way round a cone,	Fastest in Class Plus 20

you can retrace your steps, and this will not be counted as a wrong test

O) No penalties will be applied for late arrival other than maximum lateness

23. Data Protection Act
